

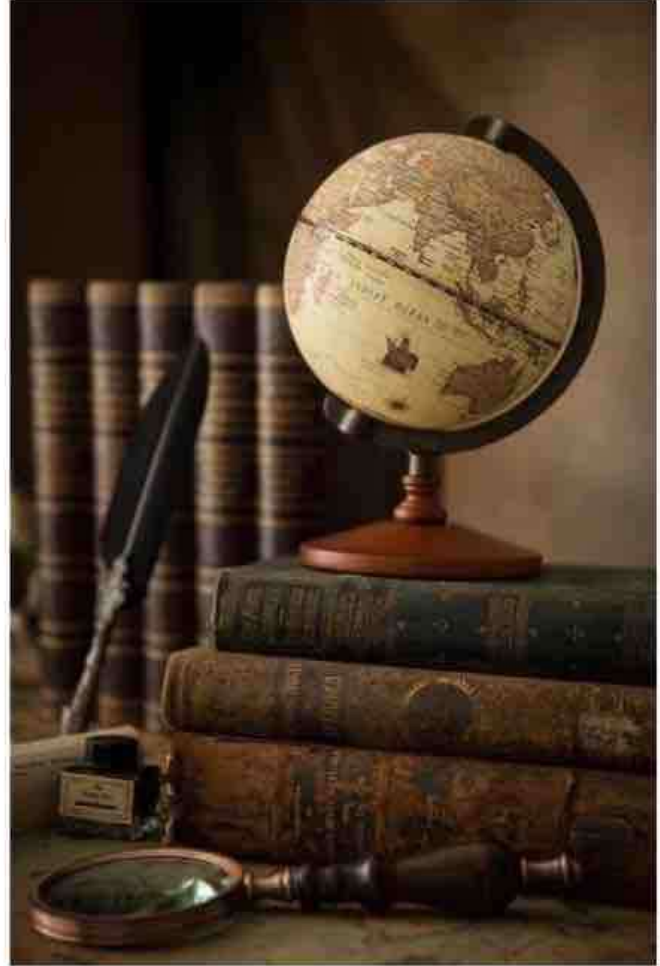

RULES & REGULATION

- Participants from Other Colleges are expected to possess their **College ID** cards throughout their stay at Loyola College.
- They should bring a **BONAFIDE LETTER** from the Head of the Department or the Principal of the college, permitting him/her to attend the department festival in Loyola College. Failing which the participants will not be permitted to enter the Campus.
- **Dress Code** should be strictly adhered to. (Boys: Round Neck T-Shirts, Torn Jeans, Hoodie T-Shirts, Track Pants, T-Shirt with abusive words or pictures are **NOT allowed**. Only full length pants are allowed. Girls: T Shirt, Torn Jeans, Sleeveless are **NOT allowed**).



RULES & REGULATION

- Students are instructed not to bring their friends to the department festival.
- Students are warned not to misuse or abuse the camera and cell phones inside the campus. If found misused, it will be confiscated and the students will be fined for the same.
- All participants & students are expected to maintain decorum throughout their stay at Loyola College.
- The college main gates will be closed at 8:30 am. All participants are expected to enter the college premises before 8:30 am.



LOYOLA INTERNATIONAL SUMMIT



A team of 4 members would be formed by drawing slots.

- The teams would pick a chit to choose an organization and a member country.
- Adequate amount of time would be provided to each team for research and discussion.
- The topic of the discussion would be based on contemporary security issues, international conflicts, climate change and sustainable development etc.
- Each member of the team puts forth their respective country's perspective on the motion, then a few minutes will be provided to reach a consensus and pass a resolution accordingly.
- The team would be marked based on the following criteria:-
 - 1) Their body language, style of articulation and confidence;
 - 2) The content of their speech;
 - 3) The ability of the team members to reach a consensus;
 - 4) The quality of the resolution passed by each team.
- Number of participants per college is NOT LIMITED.

WAR OF WORDS



A **parliamentary debate model** will be followed.

- No of participants per team: 2
- Two on two teams are formed and assigned proposition and opposition by the speaker.
- The speaker of the house would introduce each debater before the speech.
- First member of opposition constructs the debate followed by the first member of proposition. (max. 1 min each)
- Then the second member of opposition upholds the case by pulling across the information that was not addressed by the proposition party member and responds to the proposition party arguments. (max. 1 min)
- The second member of proposition party responds to the arguments made by opposition party and adds few more points. (max. 1 min)
- In the Rebuttal round, both the teams state why their side should win by giving brief information and should answer the questions by the speaker. No new arguments should be made in the rebuttal.
- Topics would be given 15 minutes before the event.
- Number of registrations per college is NOT LIMITED.

Quiz event

- 1st Round would be Trivia Royale;
- 2nd Round would be Rapid Fire;
- 3rd Round would be The Eyes and the Ears;
- Final Round would be The Game Changer.

Rules:-

- 1) 2 members per team
- 2) Only registered teams can participate in the quiz.
- 3) Details and rules regarding each round would be explained before commencement of each round.
- 4) The quiz committee's decision will be final.
- 5) All questions will be related to International Relations.

THE MULTICULTURAL MOSAIC



The teams are expected to demonstrate the culture of any one country of their choice without using any sort of music or dance.

- The main focus of the event is **cooking without fire**.
- The participants are required to bring their own utensils and ingredients.
- The participants are expected to speak a few words in an appealing and convincing way about their country (the official language of the country can be used) and demonstrate the various features of the country creatively.
- The participants would be judged based on uniqueness of the country, creativity, coordination, teamwork and the overall impact of the performance (precision is not a factor).
- 1) Each team should consist of 2 to 5 members.
- 2) The participants would be provided adequate time for cooking.
- 3) Each team would be provided with 3 minutes to demonstrate their country.
- 4) Any form of vulgarity or obscenity is strictly prohibited.
- Number of teams per college is NOT LIMITED. All members of the team should register individually.

SHIPWRECK

- Participants would be given a character by the judging panel.
- The scenario is that they are stuck on a sinking ship.
- Participants need to convince the captain of the ship to give them the sole life jacket and why they believe they are a better choice, deserving of the life jacket than any other character on the ship.
- It is an individual event.
- Preparation time: 5 minutes
- Speaking time: 2 minutes
- Rules and Regulations :-

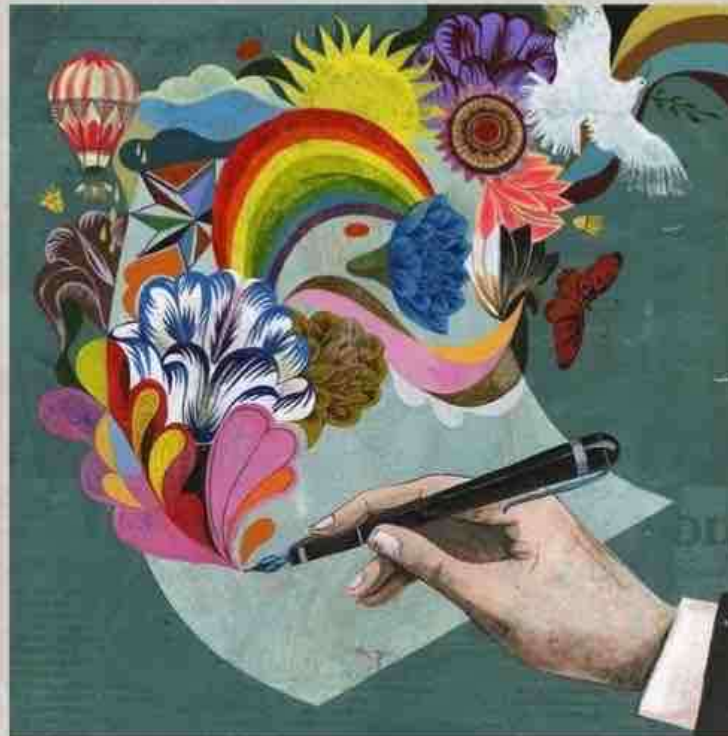
FACE PAINTING
