

### DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

### **GENERAL RULES:**

- 1. - 2. Any participant who is found disturbing the program / creating nuisance will be asked to leave the campus immediately.
- 3. Dress Code should be strictly adhered to. (Boys: Round Neck T-Shirts, Torn Jeans, Hoodie T-Shirts, Track Pants, T-Shirt with abusive words or pictures are NOT allowed. Full length pants are only allowed. Girls: T-Shirt, Torn Jeans, Sleeveless are NOT allowed).
- 4. Regulations laid down by Loyola College regarding usage of Camera Mobile Phones are applicable for other college students also. Any student will be asked to vacate the campus if he / she abuses / misuses the camera mobile phone within the campus.
- 5. The participants are asked to report to the venue ahead of time and they are expected to be present only in and around the venue allotted for the specific department.
- 6. Only those students who are pursuing their UG degree can participate.
- 7. Registration for all the events can be done by calling the person concerned.
- 8. Participants must report before 8.30a.m. for registrations and for specific events 20 minutes prior to the event.
- 9. Loyola College won't be responsible for any loss of participant's belongings.
- 10. Smoking or drinking is strictly prohibited inside the Campus.
- 11. Judge's decision in all the events will be final and binding. Unnecessary arguments will lead to disqualification.
- 12. Results announced once are final.
- 13. All the above Rules are applicable for all the events and any violation will lead to disqualification.
- 14. Participants are free to express their grievances (if any) regarding any misconduct /misbehaviour by any student of Loyola College to the Vice Principal (Administration) of Shift I or II.
