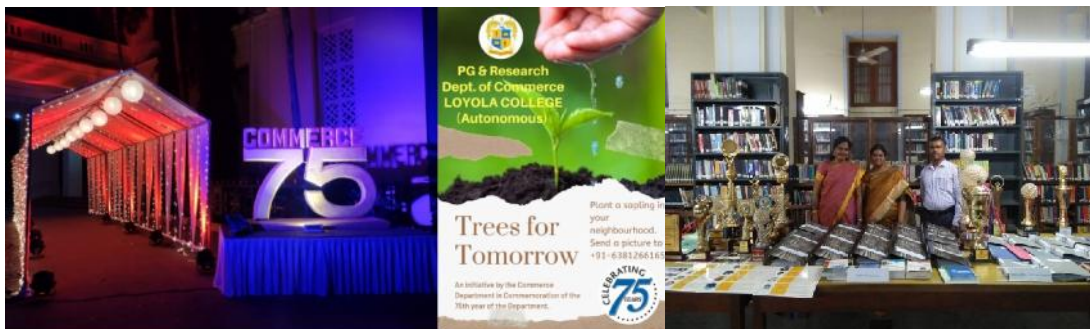

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES 2019-2020
