

## **Students – Admission from Outreach intervention slums**

The Department of Service Learning (Outreach) planned to organize a summer camp for the students who have completed 12<sup>th</sup> standard (2016-17). These students were selected from 41 outreach intervention slums. They were identified by 2<sup>nd</sup> year UG students (2016-17) in their respective outreach areas. Around 143 students were identified and enrolled for the summer camp. This program was primarily aimed at the development of their leadership skills, and also included career guidance. On the final day of summer camp, they were given guidance on the online applying procedure and course selection in Loyola College.

Out of 143 students, 58 students applied various courses at Loyola College. Many of them were first generation students with a single parent from a vulnerable community. All of them appeared for the interview. They were scrutinized with many proceedings and finally Loyola College decided to give an opportunity to 43 students.

Students and their parents were very happy to get admission in Loyola College and they were thankful to Loyola College.
