REGULATIONS 10.5: PUBLIC VIVA-VOCE EXAMINATION:

A Candidate whose thesis has been recommended for the award of the degree by the Board of Examiners who valued the thesis shall submit himself/herself to a public viva-voce examination conducted by the supervisor and one external examiner appointed by the Vice-Chancellor in the department/institution where the research work was conducted. A copy of the thesis of the candidate appearing for the public viva-voce examination shall be deposited in the departmental library for perusal of those interested in thesis before the conduct of the public viva-voce examination, together with appropriate public notice issued by the supervisor for the purpose. Member of the department in the subject concerned where the candidate conducted research and outside specialists, if any, may participate in the public viva-voce examination. The supervisor shall convey to the university, the result of such public viva-voce examination with their signature, designation and address. A candidate who is also successful at the public viva-voce examination shall be declared to have qualified for the Ph.D. degree by the Vice-Chancellor and the ratification of the Syndicate be obtained for the same in due course.
