GENERAL RULES FOR THE EVENTS

Block n Tackle

“Life is more like a game of football .In order to score points,you need to tackle your problems and block your fear”

- ✓ Only one participant can participate in this event.
- ✓ Each participant should speak for (block) and against (tackle) the topic simultaneously.
- ✓ Topics will be given on the spot.
- ✓ Each participant will have to speak for 5 minutes.

Spill the word:

“Are you ad-dicted to diction?”

It is an individual event.

A college can be represented by a maximum of 2 participants.

A word would be given on the spot.Participants will be required to

- * Spell the word
- * Give its meaning
- * Should speak for about 3 minutes.

Decision of the judges will be final.

Connection:

“There is no WiFi in the Forest, but I promise you will find a better Connection”

Literature based triple rounds to be hosted .

Two teams can participate from a college.

Each team should consist of three members.

The team should ensure atleast one participant is able to read Tamil.

The slides will be projected on screen for a minute.

Verse It

“ Let the verse-atile be the victor”

- It is an individual event .
- A college can send a maximum of two participants.
- Topic will be given on the spot. 30 minutes will be allotted for writing.
- Participants will also have to recite what they have written.
- Judgement will be based on both the content and the way of presentation .
- The decision of the judges will be final.

Literary Parade:

“The creative adult is the child who survived. So here is a chance to let lose the child in you . But what is the use without rules? “

- Each college will be represented by 5 members.
- Each team should represent a particular literary age.
- Each team would be provided with around 5 to 7 minutes to perform.
- Following the parade there will be a Q/A session.

Lit-Quiz:

“Strive, to seek and to find”

- Lit-Quiz will have 2 rounds in it ,Prelims and Finals.
- Questions will be based on Literature and movies based on literature.
- 2 students can participate in this event.
- Quiz master's decision will be the final word.



Dumb Charadas 2.0

“Act to save yourself. Take this chance to be a triple threat.”

There will be a total of 3 rounds.

Each college can have only one team consisting of two members.

The first round will be “**Dumb Charads**”.

- Each group will be given 2 minutes to act out and get the answers.
- Winners will be decided according to the time they take to get the answer.
- A total of 10 teams will be selected to move to the next round.

The second round will be “**Enact-It**”.

- The team members will be given a video to view before the event.
- The video will be shown once again at the venue.
- The teams will be given 2 minutes to act out the scene.
- A total of five teams will be selected for the final round.

The third and final round will be “**Shipwreck**”

- The team will be given a total of 7 minutes, 5 minutes of preparation and 2 minutes of performance.
- Both the participants will debate against each other.
- They will be evaluated on the basis of their debating skills.

Devil's Advocate:

“Defend not for the Angel But for the Devil’.
Win the tittle of being the Best Devil's Advocate.

- Only one participant can participate in this event.
- Preparation for round 1 will be 3 minutes.
- Round 1 will be for 5 minutes (3 minutes for preparation+2 minutes for performance)
- Round 2 will be for 6 minutes (3 minutes for preparation+3 minutes for performance).
- Characters for round 1 will be allotted from the Renaissance Age. Characters for round 2 will be allotted from the literary works of Nineteenth century.
- Only the qualified participants will enter the second round.
- Decision of the judges will be final.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- ✓ Participants from other Colleges are expected to possess their College ID Card throughout their stay in Loyola College and also should bring a **BONAFIDE LETTER** from the Head of the Department permitting him/her to attend the department festival in Loyola College.
- ✓ Dress Code should be strictly adhered to. (Boys: Round Neck T-Shirt, Torn Jeans, Hoodie T-Shirts, Track Pants, T-Shirt with abusive words or pictures are **NOT ALLOWED**. Only full length pants are allowed. Girls: T-Shirt, Torn Jeans, Sleeveless are **NOT allowed**).
- ✓ Regulations laid down by Loyola College regarding usage of Camera Mobile Phones are applicable for other college students also. The student will be asked to vacate the campus if he/she abuses/misuses the camera mobile phone within the campus.
- ✓ The participants are asked to report to the venue ahead of time and they need to be present only in and around the venue allotted for the specific department.
