GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Open to all departments and all college students
- 2 All participants must bring their physical Identity Card or Bonafide certificate for verification of Registration
- 3 Judges' decisions will be final and binding on all events. Any grievances should be conveyed in writing to the Equity and Grievance committee
- 4 For the team events, cross-year, cross-department and cross-college teams are allowed
- 5 Vulgarity in any form in any event will lead to immediate disqualification
- 6 Participants should take note of event timings and venues to avoid confusions. We will be running on a tight schedule and will not accept any delays due to participants
- 7 Participants are allowed to participate in multiple events but no event shall be halted or paused due to a participant being in another event. If a participant is not there in an event when he/she is supposed to be in (at least 1 participant should be there for team events), they will be marked 0 for the round and the event will proceed
- 8 The dress-code for the fest is business formals/ business casuals. Please check with the organizing committee for specifics as if you are not following the dress code, you wil not be allowed access to the venue
- 9 Laptops / Mobile Phones may be allowed as per event discretion

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 10 Each college contingent that is challenging for the Overalls is requested to nominate a Point of Contact (POC)/Contingent Leader (CL) to handle all communications with respect to the college and the fest
- 11 Participants from Other Colleges are expect to possess their College ID cards throughout their stay in Loyola College and also should bring BONAFIDE LETTER from the Head of the Department or the Principal of the college, permitting them to attend the department festival in Loyola College. Failing which the participants will not be permitted to enter into the Campus
- 12 Any participants who is found disturbing the program/creating nuisance will be asked to leave the campus immediately.
- 13 Dress Code should be strictly adhered to (Boys: Round Neck T-Shirts, Torn Jeans, Hoodie T-Shirts, Track Pants, T-Shirt with abusive words or pictures are NOT allowed. Full length pants is only allowed. Girls: T-Shirt, Torn Jeans, Sleeveless are NOT allowed).
- 14 Regulations laid down by Loyola College regarding usage of Camera Mobile Phones are applicable for other college students also. Any students will be asked to vacate the campus if he/she abuses/misuses the camera mobile phone within the campus.
- 15 The participants are asked to report to the venue ahead of time and they need to be present only in and around the venue allotted for the specific department.
- 16 Participants are free to express their grievances (if any) regarding any misconduct/misbehavior by any student of Loyola College to the Vice Principal (Administration) of Shift I or II. Their office is located in the Main Building Ground Floor (Room No.3) and Jubilee Building Ground Floor (Room No.JG 10) respectively.
