

Justice Jasti Chelameswar

Justice Jasti Chelameswar was graduated in B.Sc. Physics from Loyola College and in law from Andhra University, Visakhapatnam, in 1976.

He enrolled himself as an Advocate in High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Hyderabad in 1976 and practised under senior Advocates like Dr.B.Bhimaraju, Sri.P.Rajaroo, and Sri.K.Srinivasa Murthy. He is specialized in Constitutional Law, Election Laws, Central Excise, Customs, Income Tax and Criminal Law.

He was appointed as Standing Counsel of A.P.Lokayukta in 1985 and 1986. Further, he worked as Government Pleader for Home Affairs in High Court in 1988 and 1989. Subsequently, he was designated as Senior Counsel in 1995 and appointed as Additional Advocate General on 13.10.1995.

Then, he was elevated as Additional Judge of High Court of Andhra Pradesh on 23.6.1997 and as Judge in 17.5.1999 and as Chief Justice of Gauhati High Court in 2007.

Later, in 2010, he was transferred to Kerala High Court and assumed charge as Chief Justice of Kerala. Once again, he was promoted as Judge, Supreme Court of India on 10th October, 2011.

During his tenure as Advocate, Judge and Justice, he worked for reforms and stood for transparency.
