

## **Shri Vijay Narayan**

Shri Vijay Narayan is an alumnus of Loyola College. After completing his graduation 1977, he joined Law College, Madras in 1978 and graduated in 1982.

Subsequently, he joined the chambers of Shri P. Chidambaram, senior advocate and worked with him until he became a Member of Parliament. In the course of the last 34 years of practice, Vijay Narayan has successfully defended a wide variety of cases including cases on service law, labour law, constitutional law, administrative law and commercial law. In consideration of his practice, High Court of Madras designated him as a Senior Advocate in 2004. He has appeared very often before the Supreme Court of India and in almost all High Courts of India.

Shri Vijay Narayan is from a family of lawyers. His grandfather was the legendary M.K. Nambyar, who, in the early days of the Constitution, was responsible to a great extent for the development of constitutional law in India. Shri K. K. Venugopal, his uncle, is an eminent constitutional lawyer in the Supreme Court of India. Shri Sardar K.M. Panikkar, his maternal grandfather, was a member of the Constituent assembly, an ambassador to China, France and Egypt and was also one of the three members of the States Reorganisation Commission.
