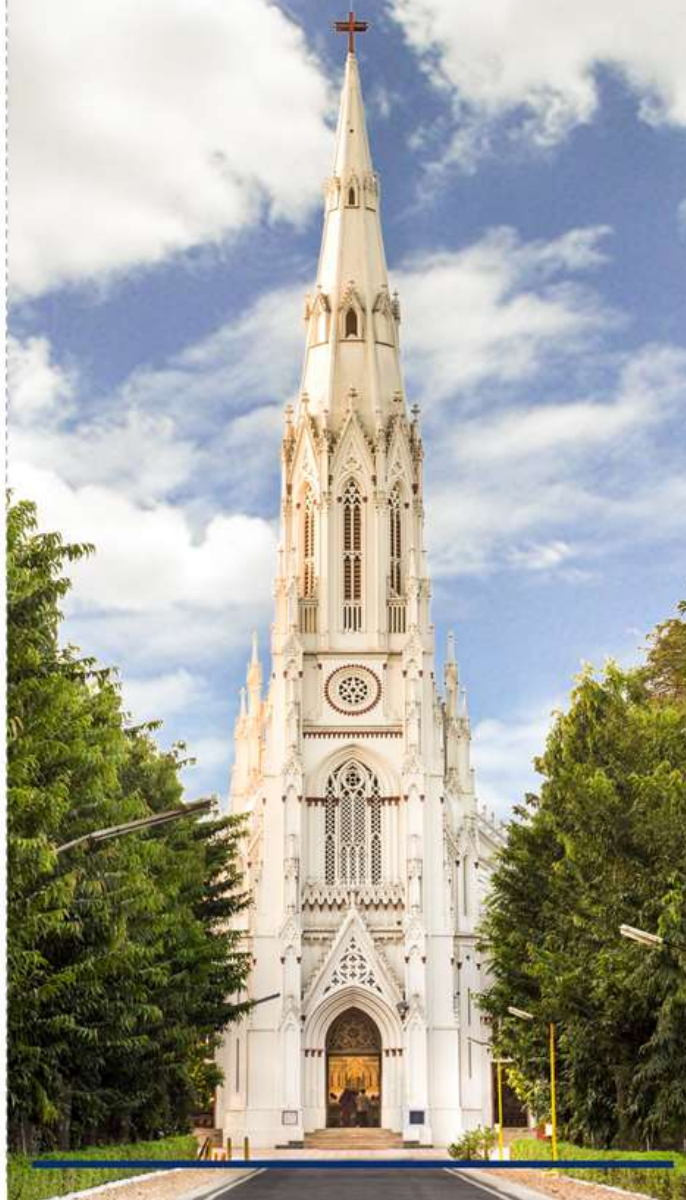

ABOUT THE EVENT

The debate, organized along with The Dean of Students Office which aims to promote debating in the city and expose the participants to past and contemporary issues of both national and global importance. Participants are welcome to prove their debating prowess and sway the audience with their exemplary oratory skills.

The first edition of Blitzkrieg took place on 3rd March, 2018. RULES

The event will consist of three rounds:

Round 1: Prelims [50 teams]

Round 2: Semifinals [10 teams]

Round 3: Finals [2 teams]

There will be no questions [POI] asked in Round 1 and Round 2, but will be allowed in the Finals.

Points will be awarded on three criteria:

Content - 20 points

Structure - 10 points

Analysis - 20 points

The top teams from Round 1 and Round 2 will advance to the next level based on the points scored.

Topics for the debate will be picked from various genres : Politics, Law, Economics, Science & Technology, Religion, Philosophy, etc.

The participants are at liberty to choose and rank their topics. Based on the ranking by both the teams, a topic will be chosen for the debate.

Institutional teams as well as cross college teams are allowed to participate in this event.
