

FAQs BBA France - Admissions

1. Who can apply for the Loyola - IÉSEG Twinning Programme?

The Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA France) Degree Course is a Twinning Programme of Loyola College, Chennai and IÉSEG School of Management, Lille Catholic University, France. Students are required to complete their 1st and 2nd year of study at Loyola College and pursue their 3rd year of study at IESEG, School of Management at Lille France.

- Students who have secured a minimum 60% overall grade in their +2 board exams.
- Students who have completed their higher secondary through the following boards can apply:
 - ✓ State Boards
 - ✓ CBSE
 - ✓ ICSE
 - ✓ International Baccalaureate
 - ✓ IGCSE
 - ✓ CISCE
 - ✓ Others

2. Are the courses in French or English?

- The medium of instruction will be in English.
- French language will also be simultaneously taught after the commencement of the course.

3. Can non-commerce/non-mathematics students apply for this programme?

- Students from both streams of Commerce and Science can apply for this course.
- A one week Bridge course in Financial Accounting, Mathematics and Economics will be conducted for all the fresher's enrolled in for the programme.

4. If I don't speak any French can I still apply?

- Yes! Non- Francophone students can apply for this programme. However, French will be a mandatory subject for all the students enrolled for the programme. Special coaching will be provided to the non-francophone students.

5. What are the class timings?

- The timings of the classes are from 8.15 A.M. to 03.15 P.M. (Monday – Friday)

6. When and how do I apply for the programme?

- The BBA France applications will be available online after the publication of the Tamil Nadu Higher Secondary Results
- Log on to www.loyolacollege.edu and click on BBA France admissions.
- Fill in and submit the application online.
- If your higher secondary results are not released, apply with your pre board scores.

7. What is the deadline for the submission of the application forms?

- 1st June 2018

8. What is the Admission Procedure?

- There will be an Entrance Exam and a Personal Interview for all the students who have applied for the BBA France Programme.
- A pass in the entrance exam is required.
- Intimation will be sent to all the selected students via email within one week after the completion of the entrance exam.

9. When will the Entrance Examination and the Personal Interview be held?

- 4th June – 7th June 2018 by 9 A.M. at Loyola College, Chennai.
- For Out Station candidates the personal interview will be conducted on the same day of the entrance exam and may even spill over to the next day i.e.5th June 2018.

- For Chennai candidates the Interview will be conducted on the next 2 days after the entrance exam by 9 A.M.

10. Do I have to take any additional tests/exams to go to France?

- All BBA France students are expected to clear their DELF A1 and DELF A2 level French Language Exams before they go for their 3rd year of study to France.
- IELTS with the minimum of score of 6.5 is also required.

11. What are the major subjects for the course?

- Financial Accounting I & II
- Business Mathematics I & II
- Business Statistics I & II
- Financial Management I & II
- Micro And Macro Economics
- Civil & Business Law
- Econometrics
- Operations Management
- Introduction to Marketing
- Business & Management

Papers in Business English and French will be taught in all 4 semesters of study in Loyola College.

12. Can non-Indian residents apply?

- Yes candidates from all parts of the world can apply for this programme.

13. Does Loyola College Provide Hostel Accommodation for BBA France students?

- Hostel accommodation is available for non- residential students, but will have to be applied separately and will be considered by the College management independently.

- However hostel accommodation is not connected with the BBA France admissions.
- Parallel admission will be done for Hostel accommodation in the Loyola Campus, candidates will have to apply on a separate application for Hostel accommodations.
- BBA France admissions does not guarantee the Hostel Accommodation.

14. Does IESEG provide Hostel Accommodation for BBA France students in the 3rd year?

- Students can apply for Hostel accommodation (Concordia) in IESEG for their 3rd year of study.
- Private accommodation outside the IESEG campus works out to be inexpensive in Lille.

15. Is the programme recognized by the UGC?

- The BBA France twinning programme is a full time course offered by IESEG School of Management and IESEG is affiliated to the Catholic University of Lille (France).
- Since the degree is offered by IESEG (France), the UGC does not recognize this programme.
- However, students earning the degree through IESEG can apply for their Master's Degree in all Universities across the globe.
- Indian universities consider these degrees as Foreign Degrees.

16. What does the fees include?

The indicative tuition fee, for the 1st and 2nd year of study (4 Semesters) at Loyola College is as follows, and this could be revised.

17. What is the accreditation for IESEG?

- IESEG is ranked 31st in the world and 1st in France for the Post Baccalaureate in Management by Financial Times (2016).
- IESEG obtained the prestigious EQUIS Accreditation in April 2012 and AACSB Accreditation in March 2013 – being the only French business school recruiting students from high school with this individual accreditation.
- IESEG has also obtained the prestigious AMBA Accreditation in the year 2016
- IESEG is one among the top Business Schools to obtain the triple crown accreditation of the AACSB, EQUIS & AMBA

18. If I join this programme, can I be assured that I can go to France in the third year?

- The BBA France programme trains each and every student to excel in their academics.
- Students will be evaluated by the Loyola and IESEG team at the end of every academic year in order to be promoted to the next year.
- Student evaluation will be executed with the following criteria:
 - a) Attendance – Minimum 75%
 - b) Examinations
 - c) Attitude

If students are found to be below average on the above mentioned criteria, they will be asked to repeat the year/leave the programme.

19. Is there any Internship for this Programme?

- All 1st year BBA France students are expected to take up a 3 week Summer
- Internship (General) during April – May every year.
- All 2nd year BBA France students are expected to take up a 3 week Summer

Internship on Sales & Marketing during April – May every year.
