#### **About the Event:**

Loyola's Institutions Innovation Council (LIIC) conducted a webinar on "Intellectual Property Rights" on 19th February,2021 on the Cisco WebEx platform. There was a total of 200 participants who attended the event which included students, faculty and the resource person.

The resource person for the day Dr.Dinesh Kumar Vannam, Assiatant Vice President, addressed the gathering. Dr Dinesh started off his presentation by enlightening the gathering about the meaning of Intellectual Property Rights as defined by World Intellectual Property Organization. He threw light on the three important features of IPR which included:

- Relation of Human Intellects
- Infinite Renewable Resource
- New Wealth of Nations

He further went on to explain the classification of IPR which are divided into two main headings; Industrial Property Rights and Copyrights. These headings are further subdivided as follows:

- Industrial Property Rights:
- Patent
- Trademarks
- Industrial Trademarks
- Geographical Indications

## Copyrights:

- Music
- Literature
- Creativity
- Works of Art

He explained various types of IPR by citing the example of Mobile phone and how each component can be protected.

In the second half of the presentation, he gave a success formula for start-ups or businesses called "Panchsheel" which included Creativity, Invention, Innovation, IPR and lastly Entrepreneurship. He further went on to explain the various features of a Patent which provides the benefit of exclusive rights, monopoly for a period of at least 20 years and Invention. He also briefed about how innovators can patent the ideas and take it forward to the market.

He concluded his presentation by throwing light on the concept of Novelty and the significance of "Invention" and "Inventive step". He encouraged all the participants to make it a point to protect their idea as innovation is the key to development.
