About Mr. R. P. Ranga

R.P.Ranga (known as C. R. Panduranga Rao) completed his Mathematics Honours from Loyola College, Madras between 1934 and 1939. His teachers are eminent professors like Rev. Fr. Vion, Raghava Shastri, Prof. Sundaram Iyer and Prof. Mahalingam. He joined the service in Government of India and after Independence was assigned to the Indian Audit and Accounts Service.

Mr. Ranga served for some years as a member of the Governing Council of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India and as a member of the Governing Council of the Salar Jung Museum. At the time of his retirement in 1977, he was Deputy Comptroller and Auditor General of India. After retirement, he served as an independent director of various companies including Andhra Sugars and Textool.

Throughout his life, Mr. Ranga retained an avid interest in Mathematics. Out of the love for his subject, he taught and coached numerous youngsters. His interests included Non-Euclidean Geometry, Boolean Algebra and Set Theory.

Mr. Ranga passed away in 2010 after leading a full life. As a gesture of gratitude, the department of Mathematics, Loyola College, the Alma Mater has been endowed by his family to support Education and Research in Mathematics.
