Ceramic Workshop at Dakshinachitra 10 January 2020



Department of DDU KAUSHAL Kendra organised a field workshop on ceramics for the first year B.Voc and M.Voc 3D Animation students on 10 January 2020. The workshop was conducted at Dakshinathitra, in the outskirts of Chennai, by ace ceramic artist Mr. Potrarasan.

The workshop helped students explore the art of figure modelling and understand the techniques involved in sculpting human anatomy. A total of 51 students were given individual workspace to work with the ceramic clay along with 3 department faculties. Mr. Potrarasan briefed them on different types of clays used and the procedure for making ceramics – modelling, drying, firing and glazing.

After teaching them basics, each student was given clay to begin with the base. Once the base was almost finished, the next step of adding details was taught by the artist step by step in detail. With an understanding on the procedure involved, students used their creativity to further develop the model they imagined.
