



MR/MS RENATUS (TITLE EVENT)

A surprise event took place in Quinn Hall, attracting a significant number of enthusiastic participants. The unique aspect of the event was that the tasks were assigned spontaneously, challenging the participants to think quickly and adapt to the situation. **U.B. Abarajith** from **SRM Ramapuram** stood out with his remarkable performance, ultimately winning the title. The event was a memorable experience for everyone involved, showcasing creativity, quick thinking, and competitive spirit.



CASTAWAY (SHIPWRECK)

The Shipwreck Event was a speaking competition where participants, assigned different characters, had to convince the captain to give them the sole lifejacket on a sinking ship. Manobharati from SRM won 1st place, and Keerthana from Anna Adharsh secured 2nd place.



LIVE MONOPOLY:

Live Monopoly was a unique event that gave an individual a new perspective on the traditional board game. The Top 6 teams were to play the traditional game in a life size monopoly board where they could negotiate prices and properties whilst also being a game piece. Out of Which **D.G Vaishnav** Emerged to be the **winner** and **MCC** Emerged to be the **winners and runner** up of the event.



AUCTION ARENA (IPL AUCTION)

The most common event every one of us come across in many of the cultural festivals is IPL Auction. There was a large number of participants in which only 10 teams were selected to bid for their players in the auction arena. On the whole, 30 Teams (2-4 participants per team), of which **RKM Vivekananda** Secured **first place** and **D.G Vaishnav emerged as runner up.**



PACK IT, PITCH IT (PRODUCT PACKAGING)

The "Pack It, Pitch It" event required teams to select products from a provided list and create a marketing plan, including branding and sales promotion strategies. MOP Vaishnav College, Chennai, won first place, while D.G Vaishnav College secured second place.

VALEDICTORY




