The Postgraduate and Research Department of Commerce began its academic year 2021-22 through offline (face-to-face) mode on 6th August, 2021 with the inaugural prayer service and orientation sessions for UG and PG students. Along with academic activities, the students were encouraged to pursue online courses. The students showed their progress in the academic, sports and in cultural activities.

The Loyola Commerce Association (LCA) that started functioning on 1st November 2021 was led by Dr. N. Maria Joseph, with the election of the office bearers. The association gave a supportive hand to the department in organizing various academic, intellectual, and cultural activities. Our students brought credentials to the department by winning the overall trophy on Sports Day, March Past and won the overall trophy in the Ovations 2022.

The department brought out its E Newsletter "PULSE" which was highly appreciated by the academicians and the students. The department took part in the Christmas Carol and won prizes by rendering devotional songs. Parent Teachers Meeting was held on 7th May 2022, during which the parents highly appreciated the management and the department for giving a perfect formation of their wards.
