A memorial tribute was organised to pay respect to Dr. Joseph Jayaraj who passed away on 9th February 2022 and the event was conducted in LS Hall from 12.20 pm to 1.20 pm.

In his message, Rev. Fr. Principal shared that Dr. Jayaraj took the name of the college to other countries, introduced the restructuring program in the college, and was the brainchild behind opening of the Centre for International Program (now LIAC) in Loyola College.

The members present in the meeting acknowledged that Dr. Jayaraj was a man of great positivity, never talked anything ill about others and always supported and guided the younger staff members to achieve academic excellence.
