- > Challenges of writing the sections of abstract, introduction, and methodology
- > Writing the results, conclusion, discussion, and references sections.
- Examination of the above in the context of international journals.
- Carrying out meaningful research inputs to design manuscripts
- > Assessing journals under Web of Science regarding commerce and economics discipline
- > Need to identify and establish a logical framework for research publication.
- Reasons for rejection of a research article
- Research article components, functions, and preferred writing style.
- > Rules for writing the subsections of a research article.

Dr. R. Vijay Solomon supplied worksheets and engaged the participants on an interesting discussion based on the responses given by them.
