

Special English Coaching Classes

Loyola Students Support Services (LSSS) and the Department of English jointly organize Special English Coaching Classes (SECC) for the 1st year UG students. The objective of the programme is to help the poor and the Tamil Medium students to excel in their academics in Loyola College.



Two hundred and fifty students have registered for SECC and they will benefit from the programme. Totally there are five sections. Each section has fifty students. Four sections will be conducted from 2.00 P.M. to 3.00 P.M. in the afternoon for Shift - I students, and one section in the morning from 11.00 A.M. to 12.00 Noon for Shift - II students.
