

Orientation Program – 26th June 2023

The Outreach Orientation program for the UG second year students of Commerce A Section, Sociology, Economics and B. Voc. Digital Journalism was conducted on 26th June in L.S. Hall. The program started at 2.35 pm with a prayer song. Ms. Jeyamani Divya Christudoss, Vice Principal Shift 2 addressed the students about the importance of Outreach and she mentioned that it was mandatory for the students to complete their Outreach credits in order to get their degree. She also mentioned about the attitudinal changes and the changes in an individual's behavior and perception that could be brought about through the Outreach program.
