UNIVERSITY OF MADRAS, Ph.D. REGULATIONS 10.5: PUBLIC VIVA-VOCE EXAMINATION

Candidate whose thesis has been recommended for the award of the degree by the Board of Examiners who valued the thesis shall submit themselves to a public viva-voce examination conducted by the Joint supervisors and one external examiner appointed by the Syndicate in the department/institution where the research work was conducted.
